

Caregiving for Parents with Alzheimer's and Dementia Study

OSU researcher is looking for adult children who are caregivers for their parents to take part in a study on economic hardship experienced as a caregiver.

- Interview and short survey in person or over the phone
- Approximately one hour long
- Confidential, all data stored securely
- Must be 18 years of age or older
- Must be the current or previous primary caregiver for a parent with Alzheimer's or Dementia. *A caregiver provides at least one hour per week of unpaid care (e.g. household tasks, managing finances or health, helping with activities of daily living).*
- Will receive \$20 for participating

This OSU study investigates:

- What has been your experience as a caregiver?
- What types of economic sacrifices have you made since becoming a caregiver?
- How do you anticipate that your caregiving experiences will affect you throughout your life?
